

FIVE WAYS TO DEMONSTRATE GOOD IMPACT PRACTICE TO A FUNDER

ONE Conduct a 'Measuring Up!' self-assessment of your Impact Practice and share results with funders:
www.inspiringimpact.org/measuring-up/

TWO Submit a theory of change or monitoring and evaluation framework that demonstrates how your proposed project will affect change and how you plan to measure it

THREE If you're short of time, submit a logic model showing your project's proposed inputs, processes, outputs, outcomes and impact

FOUR Sign up to the principles set out in the Code of Good Impact Practice to show your public commitment:

FIVE When asked about how you measure impact or do monitoring and evaluation, structure your answer in four parts according to the cycle of good impact practice: plan, do, assess, review
