

WHAT IS GDPR SPECIAL CATEGORY DATA?

Article 9 of GDPR

'Personal Data' refers to any information that allows a living individual to be identified either directly or indirectly.



'Special Category Data' is a type of personal data that is especially sensitive. If exposed, it could harm an individual's rights and freedoms as a result of, for example: discrimination, identity theft or fraud, financial loss, damage to their reputation, or loss of confidentiality.

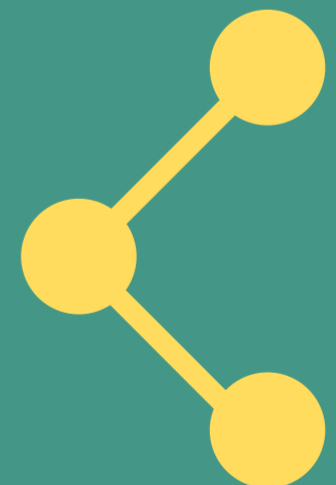
